

Integrated Arts Major/Minor Requirements Effective August 2018

Integrated Arts is designed for students who want to pursue two different disciplines in the Conservatory. This cross-disciplinary program allows students to explore and enhance their gifts in multiple ways.

The disciplines offered are:

- Music • Theatre • Musical Theatre • Theatrical Design & Technology (Tech Theatre)
- Dance • Visual Arts • Film Studies • 3D Film Animation • Broadcast/Journalism

Some of these are complementary, such as Theatre and Music or Visual Arts and Film.

Students may choose only two disciplines. The second discipline must be chosen by the end of sophomore year.

Integrated Arts Minors

1. ONE CLASS PER YEAR - 4 total classes in 4 years, in a maximum of two disciplines

- Minors will take one class each year in one discipline in 9th & 10th grades, and one class each year in a different discipline in 11th & 12th grades. This provides continuity of training in each discipline. (Example: 9-Theatre, 10-Theatre, 11-Dance, 12-Dance)
- Note: if taking music, the classes must be performance classes. AP Theory and History & Music do not count for the minor.

Integrated Arts Majors

1. SIX TOTAL CLASSES – in 4 years, in a maximum of two disciplines

- Majors will take three classes in two different disciplines.
(Example: 9-Music, 10-Music & Visual Arts, 11-Music & Visual Arts, 12-Visual Arts)

2. FOLLOW THE MINOR REQUIREMENTS OF EACH CLASS CHOSEN

- Integrated Arts Minors will follow the Minor requirements of each of the class disciplines chosen. If they choose a visual arts class, they follow Visual Arts Minor requirements.
- Integrated Arts Majors will follow the Minor requirements of the disciplines that correspond to the classes they take. If they choose a visual arts class and a music class, they follow both the Visual Arts Minor and Music Minor requirements for that year.

3. CONSERVATORY MEETING ATTENDANCE

- Held during lunch and required except for illness or conflict with academic, performance, or athletic activity.
- Minors attend the lunch meeting that corresponds to the discipline of the class they are taking. If taking a music class, attend the music meeting, etc.
- Majors attend the lunch meetings that correspond to both of the disciplines of the classes they are taking.

Additional Opportunities

• Symphonic Chorale

- In 2018-19, all Conservatory Majors & Minors in all disciplines are eligible to join this Fall Semester group.
- Members must attend a minimum of one weekly rehearsal, with flexibility to attend either tutorial period 1B or after school (day of week to be determined).
- An online rehearsal alternative is available for students with occasional scheduling conflicts, upon advance notice and approval.
- Five additional full ensemble rehearsals are also scheduled.

Three artistic opportunities for the Symphonic Chorale in 2018-19:

- Weekend camp in the mountains for all Conservatory students and faculty the weekend of Sept. 14-16, 2018.
- Performance as a large chorale with orchestra at the California Theatre on December 14, 2018.
- Optional trip to Europe to perform in June, 2019, right after school is out.

- **Arts Outreach Bible class** is available to all Conservatory students in 11th & 12th grades, but is not required.

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
